* The American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act of 2021 provided Pennsylvania with \$5 billion in emergency funding to support school districts in an effort for educational recovery. Under ARP, at least 90 percent, or \$4.5 billion, of the fund flowed to eligible public school districts and charter schools, with each entity receiving an amount proportional to the Federal Title I-A funds received in 2020 under the Every Student Succeeds Act. These funds were allocated to each District and are to be used as a means to prepare, prevent, or respond to Covid/address learning loss that has occurred as a result of the pandemic.
