SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES, FEBRUARY 3, 2010.**

President Johnson convened the special meeting of the Colonial Board of School Directors at 6:04 p.m. in the District Office General Meeting Room on February 3, 2010.

Mr. Johnson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Public Comments:** None.

**New Business:** Dr. Cotter stated that he was proud to recommend Dan Chang to the position of head football coach at Plymouth Whitemarsh High School (PWHS) effective for the 2010-2011 school year. He noted that Mr. Chang played at North Penn High School (NPHS) while Dr. Cotter was the principal there. Dr. Cotter stated that Mr. Chang later served as an assistant coach for five years at NPHS and spoke highly of Mr. Chang's qualifications and character.

Mr. Zimmer moved and Mrs. Suchsland seconded a motion to appoint Mr. Chang as PWHS head football coach. On a roll call vote, all voted in favor. The motion was carried, 9-0.

Mr. Chang thanked the Board and stated that being a head football coach was his lifelong goal. He said that he was very excited and anxious to get started. Mr. Chang added that he is looking forward to working with the student athletes and promoting integrity, trust, teamwork and perseverance. Mr. Forster stated that the six-member search committee was impressed with Mr. Chang's energy, enthusiasm and passion for the sport. He stated that he was comfortable with what Mr. Chang will bring to the program.

Mrs. Moore sought Board action to approve Concentra Medical Centers as the provider of the Hepatitis B Vaccine to any Colonial School District employees who opt to have it through June 30, 2010. The cost is \$80 per vaccine. Vaccines are administered at the Concentra Medical Centers from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Saturday.

Mrs. Moore moved and Mrs. Luken seconded a motion to approve Concentra Medical Centers as provider of the Hepatitis B vaccine. On a roll call vote, all voted in favor. The motion was carried, 9-0.
