REORGANIZATION MEETING MINUTES, DECEMBER 4, 2012**

Board Secretary David M. Sherman convened the reorganization meeting of the Colonial Board of School Directors at 7:02 p.m. in the District Office General Meeting Room on December 4, 2012.

Mr. Sherman led the Pledge of Allegiance, read the roll, and noted that the Board was accepting applications for the vacant seat through noon on Friday, December 7. He then announced that the purpose of the meeting was to elect School Board officers for the coming year and to authorize continuation of existing signature plates.

**Election of Temporary Chairperson:** Mr. Sherman sought nominations from Board members for the position of Temporary President. Mrs. Moore nominated Alan Tabachnick as Temporary President of the Reorganization Meeting. Mr. Brodsky moved to close the nominations. Mr. Sherman called for a Board vote. All voted in favor. The motion was carried, 7-0

**Election of Officers:** Mr. Tabachnick sought nominations for the position of Board President. Mrs. Moore moved to nominate Mr. Tabachnick as President. She commented that his leadership had served the Board well during the previous year. Mr. Brady seconded the motion. There being no other nominations, Mr. Tabachnick called for a vote. All voted in favor. The motion was carried, 7-0.

Mr. Tabachnick thanked the Board and stated that he looked forward to another successful and collaborative year.

Mr. Tabachnick asked the Board for nominations for Vice President. Mrs. Suchsland spoke highly of Mrs. Moore's bi-partisan leadership and stated that it was her honor to nominate Mrs. Moore for Vice President. Mr. Brodsky moved to close the nominations. Mr. Tabachnick called for a vote. All voted in favor. The motion was carried, 7-0.

Mr. Tabachnick noted that no action was needed on the signature plates as there were no changes from the previous year.

There being no other business before the Board, Mr. Tabachnick adjourned the meeting at 7:10 p.m.
