Title: Student Use of Lockers

226 *Student Use of Lockers*

All lockers made available for student use on school premises are the property of the Colonial School District. These lockers are made available for student use in storing school supplies and personal items necessary for use at school, but the lockers are not to be used to store items which cause, or can reasonably be foreseen to cause, an interference with school purposes or an educational function, or which are forbidden by state law or school rules.

The student=s use of the locker does not lessen the School District=s ownership or control of the locker. The School District retains the right to periodically inspect the locker and its contents to insure that the locker is being used in accordance with its intended purpose; and to eliminate fire or other hazards, maintain sanitary conditions, attempt to locate lost or stolen material; and to prevent use of the locker to store prohibited or dangerous materials such as weapons, illegal drugs, alcohol, contraband or any other material not specifically related to school purposes or an education function of the School District.

In the event that any weapons, illegal drugs, alcohol, contraband or other material not specifically related to school purposes or to an educational function of the School District is uncovered during an inspection of the locker being used by a student, the student shall be deemed to have consented to the removal of any such item or items from that locker.
