227.1 *Activities Code of Ethics*

The Board of School Directors of the Colonial School District recognizes the vital role athletics and other extracurricular activities play in promoting the physical, mental, social, emotional and moral development of students. It is important to note, however, that while education is a right, participation in extracurricular activities and athletics is a privilege. Along with that privilege comes certain responsibilities.

Participants in athletics and extra-curricular activities are expected to safeguard the safety of themselves and others as well as to represent themselves, and their schools in a positive manner on and off school property.

Because of the extremely harmful effects that alcohol, drugs and other illegal substances can have on the body and because of their "illegal" status for students, the use of alcohol, steroids and other drugs is strictly prohibited on and off school property for all students participating in athletics or extracurricular activities.

The attached "Activities Code of Ethics" delineates the rules and regulations pertaining to the use of inappropriate substances outside the school environment.

All violations of the "Code of Ethics" shall be reported by the Principal to the Superintendent and by the Superintendent to the Board of School Directors.
