714.1 Safety

It is the policy of the Colonial School District to provide a safe environment for all employees, students and visitors and to protect school district buildings, equipment, and other property.

A Safety Committee shall be formed to help attain these goals. The committee shall include members from all district schools and every level of district operations. The committee shall:

Review reports of periodic building inspections conducted under the auspices of the Operations and Maintenance Departments in cooperation with building personnel and recommend actions to improve the safety posture of these sites. School principals, employees, and school health care professionals will be encouraged to join maintenance and custodial personnel on the inspection teams.

Review district accident reports for evidence of safety trends and recommend to the Superintendent actions to eliminate or reduce to the greatest extent possible future accidents of a similar nature.

Share with members of the committee safety information available to individual members which may be of interest to the committee as a whole and to all employees, students and visitors who make use of district facilities.

Publish and distribute to all employees, and post in all district buildings safety guidelines, bulletins, posters, and reminders designed to heighten the safety awareness of all employees, students and visitors who make use of district facilities.

The Chairman of the Safety Committee will give quarterly reports to the Superintendent and an annual report to the Board of School Directors regarding the status of the district's Safety Program.

The complete cooperation of all personnel concerning this crucial program is expected.
