901.1 School - Community Policy Guidelines

The board of school directors believes it is essential toward the development of excellence in the education of our children that the maximum possible knowledge about goals, achievements and activities of the school district be conveyed to the public, staff and students. The board believes also that these people should be involved and consulted at as many stages as possible in the decision-making process.

Therefore, the board declares as the policy of the school district its intent to:

Demonstrate accountability to the public, through periodic evaluation in print, of goals and accomplishments of the board, administrative staff and instructional staff.

Inform the public, staff and students through various media, of policies, planning and programs.

Maintain a continuing program of internal and external information dissemination, school-community relations and staff training.

Assign staff responsibility and designate adequate finances to assure successful operation of the program.

Be accessible to the public and to representatives of the news media.

Provide opportunities for meaningful involvement of citizens, staff and students in the decision-making process and in the operation and evaluation of schools.

Review annually the district's performance in school-community relations and take appropriate corrective action when needed.
